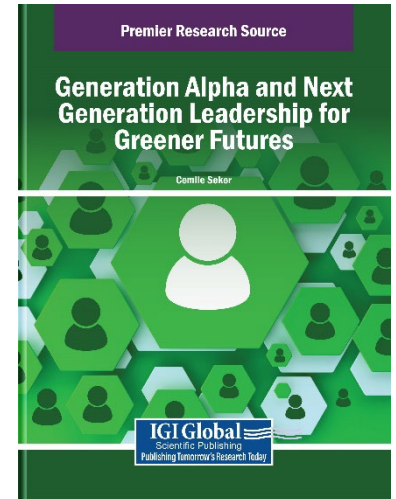


Generation Alpha and Next Generation Leadership for Greener Futures
