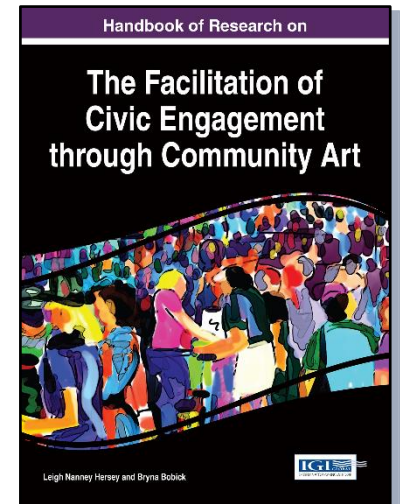
## Description:
