

E-Book Title Sharing Agreement for GWLA & Orbis Cascade Alliance Members

How Does It Work?

1. Interested institutions can contact Brittany Haynes, Assistant Director of e-Collections at bhaynes@igi-global.com, and they will be provided with title lists and other information to determine if they would like to acquire titles from IGI Global's collection of nearly **6,600 e-Books**. Free trial access (*optional*) to the entire collection is available from **April 20 – June 3, 2022**.
2. Once the trial has ended, IGI Global will provide a **COUNTER 5 Usage Report** to each institution that participated in the trial and is planning to purchase shared e-books.
3. At the conclusion of the trial period, the number of participating institutions is determined and a multiplier will be applied to the retail price of the e-books acquired through the sharing agreement (*see table below*).
4. IGI Global, in conjunction with GWLA and Orbis Cascade Alliance, will pass around a title list of available IGI Global e-books at the multiplier price, where **institutions can select which e-books they intend to purchase for the group**. IGI Global will ensure no duplicate titles are selected by various members and will work with participants **individually to finalize selections**.
5. Individual invoicing will be completed throughout June and will be finalized by **June 30, 2022**. Group access to all titles purchased as part of the agreement will also be set up by this date.
