#### **How Does It Work?**

- Interested institutions can contact Brittany Haynes, Director of e-Collections at <u>bhaynes@igi-global.com</u>, and they will be set up with free trial access (optional) to IGI Global's e-Book Collection (6,600+ e-books) content from now through May 17, 2022.
- 2. Once the trial has ended, IGI Global will provide a COUNTER 5 Usage Report to each institution that participated in the trial and is planning to purchase shared e-books.
- 3. At the conclusion of the trial period, the number of participating institutions is determined and a multiplier will be applied to the retail price of the e-books acquired through the sharing agreement (see table below).
- 4. Carolina Consortium's Management Team will pass around a title list of available IGI Global e-books, where institutions can select which e-books they plan to purchase for the group.
- 5. Institutions will finalize e-book selections by May 31, 2022.
- 6. Individual invoices and group access will be set up for all institutions and provided by **June 7, 2022**.






